

ATSSB Minutes—January 27, 2024—All Region Weekend

1. Admission is \$3.00. It is suggested that we look into a Venmo or CashApp option for collecting admission fees next year.
2. Region Fees –
 - a. Civic Center has gone up on rental price. Union dues alone are \$2400. A deposit of \$3075 was required with a final payment of \$3075.
 - b. Motion by Russell Pettitt (Seminole) to increase participation fee to \$10 per student. Second by Mario Cordova (Jayton)
 - c. Motion passed unanimously

 - b. RRC motion to make A/AA able to track up to 3A/4A. 2nd by James McEnroe (Petersburg). Passed unanimously.
 - c. Names of performing groups to be discussed—A/AA, 3A/4A—want to move away from Concert and Symphonic implying bands are levelled.
 - d. Entering into bylaws—if you enter a student, you pay for that student. Motion by RRC. 2nd by Kaylie Prentice (Loop). Passed unanimously.
 - e. Decision was made by RRC to re-label and create enough etudes to be able to align audition years for MS, HS, and Honor Band. Currently MS is on a 3 year rotation, HS on 4 year and Honor Band on 5 year.
